Can you put the following notice in the next available bar newsletter:

Pursuant to local Rule 213.1(15), Notice is hereby given that proposed forms of order are to be submitted by attorneys and individuals filing Verified Petitions to Expunge or Seal Records. Sample forms of order may be found at <http://www.in.gov/judiciary/4212.htm>. If you prefer to design their own proposed form of order, your version must contain at least as much information as the sample templates, including:

- * identifying information for the petitioner (beyond simply his or her name) such as date of birth;
 - * details for the agency that hold the records you seek to seal concerning the events covered by the Verified Petition (such as underlying cause number, date of conviction, nature of the offense); and
 - * a citation to the specific statutory provision pursuant to which your Verified Petition is filed.
- Non-conforming orders will be rejected.
