

Andre Gammage is currently Magistrate Judge in the St. Joseph Circuit Court in South Bend, Indiana. Magistrate Gammage obtained both his undergraduate degree and his J.D. from Valparaiso University. In 1988, Magistrate Gammage was admitted to the Indiana Bar Association, and he has since been admitted to practice in federal courts before the Northern and Southern Districts of Indiana and the Western District of Michigan.
